
## Communications

### Materials

Students are expected to bring a pen or pencil to class every day, plus all homework or related class materials. Class participation feedback depends on consistently bringing needed materials and being ready to contribute to the class. Students are expected to bring science workbooks to class everyday, along with ALA required supplies.

### Expectations

- > Be in your seat and quiet when the bell rings.
- Start work immediately.
- > Leave class only when dismissed by the teacher.
- > Raise your hand for permission to speak or to leave your seat.

### Rules

The ALA stundent handbook includes these classroom rules:

- Failure to follow lab safety rules will result in lost lab time. Instead of participating in lab, a student who has ignored lab safety rules will be given desk work to complete and turn in at the end of the class period

- > Sharpen pencils before the tardy bell.
- > Warm-up activities should be completed.
- > Copy objective from white board.

- > You are responsible for copying down all assignments and due dates.
- > It is **your** responsibility to come and get work you have missed if you were absent.
